### Minutes for MDNA Board Meeting: Wednesday, November 13, 2019

Attendance: 8 board members: Peter, Reuben, Shelagh, Patricia, Marius, Alex, Stephen, and Siamak

1. Minutes from June 11, 2019 approved
2. 1721 15<sup>th</sup> at Guerrero: Sean Gibson, Will Mollard, architect. \*\*\*\*The board later voted to support this project and write a letter of support.
  - extra floor given because of below market rate bonus
  - 20ft ceilings on ground floor, commercial space
  - 41 units total, 40% 2bdm, 9 units BMR
  - All are for sale, not rentals
  - There is a rear yard and a roof deck
  - Commercial space will be at market rate
  - No off street parking in building
  - Planning to apply for 2-3 curb loading spots
3. Cruise Presentation: Mason Smith, Public Affairs Manager
  - Discussion about Self driving cars
  - Company mostly based in SF
  - owned by GM
  - Intend to deploy as a ride share service
  - Months not years before deployment
  - Some cars you see are mapping, some are learning
  - Person in the passenger seat is taking notes
  - All cars learn together as a fleet
  - Will there be videos inside the car? There will be remote assistance so that passengers can communicate with headquarters.
  - Focused on cities to deploy, not as much suburbs. Focusing on urban markets, starting in SF.
  - Looking for more charging stations spots, and they want more spots to charge spread out over the city.

- Redundancy is built in so that if the car loses its connection it will still work
4. SFMTA: NE Mission Parking and Curb Management Plan: Mari Hunter, special guest
    - NE Mission parking management project
    - wants to hear from community about parking in NE Mission
    - There will be parking loss because of the fire department
    - Peter mention that blue collar workers all drive trucks and have a hard time parking
    - She explained daylighting, which is when they take away parking right at intersections to make it easier for drivers to see pedestrians
    - Cycling safety was mentioned, both safety on the bike, and bike theft, being a worry.
    - DPW does the permits for construction permits
    - Report dead driveways
  5. Membership: Discussion about certain members not showing up for meetings. In response the board voted to send out a warning. While Sanjeet chose to resign because of schedule conflicts, 2 others were removed for lack of attendance and lack of response to our warnings. The board now has 11 active members and 2 emeritus members. Our current board members are Peter, Donna, Reuben, Lucia, Siamak, Shelagh, Patricia, Marius, Alex, Stephen, and Beverly.
